

MWPHRF CRUISER

Application Process

You should use the normal MWPHRF process for requesting a handicap certificate, with slight changes to make it easier.

1. Request a LOGIN Password from MWPHRF@Mwphrf.org. You will get a temporary password. Finish and save your password.
2. Logged in to the website, request a CRUISER certificate.
3. Information Needed:
 - a. Complete the information requested including:
 - i. **Owner, Boat manufacturer, Model, and Year of Manufacture.**
 - ii. **Keel and propeller type.**
 - iii. **Rig Dimensions.**
 - iv. **Sail Information.**

Bypass all of the fields for sail dimensions (the system will use the builder supplied standard sail dimensions.) (headsail, mainsail, symmetrical spinnaker and asymmetrical spinnaker)

Indicate how the sail is flown and if you have furling for the sail.
 - v. **Describe sail construction.** – (sewn panels, laminated, molded.)

Polyester sails (typically Dacron) are made of sewn panels.

Modern hi-tech sails are either laminated or molded.
 - vi. Specialty sail page - Do not enter any information (Not allowed in Cruising Configuration)
 - vii. Upload sail maker certificates, if available.

If purchased within the last fifteen years, request the sail loft to generate a certificate.

Save, pay and return to MWPHRF.
